











#### Exercises

\*Basic idea of this day's activations is to a) get them into their architectural bodies b) help them contextualize their situation in this course/project with reference to key examples from a tradition of visionary engineering since the early 20th Century, c) with the help of this reference set, and in light of ecological perspectives on the Anthropocene, rethink their perspective on their profession/vocation/task in the weeks ahead - Remake life. Start now. There will be a big party. You have till next week to make preparations. (see assignment below)

#### Introduction:

All cases of architecture becoming art by virtue of taking its own calling too seriously. To change life, build for it. Start Now.

#### Premise 1: Architecture bases life.

#### Examples:

Constructivism invites the artist to build the base. Rational modernism thinks it has the best solution.

Surrealism understands the subconscious is architecturally determined. New Babylon fully-matured appropriation of modern building technology for liberatory/libidinal ends.

Buckminster Fuller too, more or less. (plus Frei Otto techniques) But the Situationist International's late critique refutes all architectural practice until capital is overthrown.

Tomas Saraceno floats the base. On hydrothermal power. Arakawa and Gins add in the architectural body, basis of all basing.

#### **Premise 2:** The body bases/under-/innerlies architecture.

New concepts/somatoconceptual modes: Landing site theory as the basis for a body-based aesthetics of space and architectural creation.

The architectural body as epiphany. Progressive extasis through procedural architecture.

Body-wideness as evolutionary advance/recovery in accord with A&G's counter-reductionist theory of Bioscleave.

## **Premise 3:** Perception of a new body trigger-initiates the worlding of a new world. Start now.

Mirror-neuron theory: seeing is re-acting out. Imagining is prefiguring. Models are blueprints being built. Seeing is doing is becoming in body.

Procedural architecture as proactive bodybuilding. The body of light (as in not heavy.) Will not die. Or at least not now.

What body-perception does Saraceno's *In Orbit* (or other works) Trigger? - and what new world do/could these body-perceptions contribute to initiating?

**Restating the question:** What are you doing here?

Why are you architects, and what are you building in here? What to do now, with the time and resources available, and how we have already started.












**Arakawa and Gins -** Tactically posed surrounds for the Architectural Body













## **BODY PROPER + ARCHITECTURAL SURROUND = ARCHITECTURAL BODY**






Size of architectural surround determines extent of architectural body.



Initially, a person reads a sphere through the discerning of only a limited number of areas.



Within a symmetrical surround, a person feels secure in imaging or copying onto the area behind her what she has in front of her.








